Fairy Meadow Surf Life Saving Club Inc.

Fairy Meadow Surf Life Saving Club would like to thank Fairy Meadow **Community Bank**® Branch for the support and commitment of \$15,000 over five years to our club. The money will be spent on our junior club nipper members in their ongoing training to become lifesavers.

This year we bought training boards for the clubs Nippers, these boards are an important part of teaching Nippers how to ride rescue boards, which is the most effective way to rescue someone from the surf.

This year we had seven 14 year olds gain their Surf Rescue Certificate, which is the final step before gaining their bronze medallion. Once they earn their bronze medallion they will be able to patrol the beach as lifesavers.

We currently have about 40 lifesavers that patrol Fairy Meadow beach every Sunday and all public holidays from October school holidays until Anzac Day in April. The more Nippers we can train to become lifesavers the safer the beach will be in the future.

Fairy Meadow Surf Life Saving Club appreciates the commitment from Fairy Meadow **Community Bank**[®] Branch and knows that the community appreciates the effort and service Fairy Meadow Surf Club puts into making Fairy Meadow beach safe and training the next generation of lifesavers.
