With the success of our inaugural John D'Orazio Memorial Scholarship in 2012, Bayswater Community Financial Services Ltd has continued their support of the scholarship program.

As part of our commitment to building stronger communities, \$5,000 will be provided to three academically capable local students to further their tertiary education with an opportunity for an additional year of funding depending on academic performance.

2013 has seen a change in the scholarship name to honour Mr Ian McClelland. An Honorary Freeman of the City for his 23 years of service to the local community, Ian brought the **Community Bank**® concept to Bayswater when the last bank moved out of the area in 2000. The rest, as they say is history.
