## 1. Target market for this product

## **Target Market**

The retail clients for whom this product has been designed are investors who:

- want a regular income;
- want a low risk investment;
- want an investment with a time horizon of at least two (2) years;
- can make an initial investment of at least the minimum investment amount (Class A generally \$2,000, Class B Generally \$500,000);
- want the ability to make additional contributions to their investment (including through regular periodic contributions);
- want to invest in a diversified portfolio of mainly domestic interest-bearing securities; and
- want quarterly income distributions.

## **Product Description**

The SSIF is a managed fund scheme for retail clients seeking a low-risk investment. For retail clients looking for regular income by investing in a diversified portfolio of mainly domestic interest-bearing securities with at least a 2 year time horizon. The Fund offers more than one class of unit. Both units are ranked equally on a return of capital basis and have the same investment portfolio. This fund also allows investors to receive quarterly income distributions.

## Product key attributes

The key attributes of this product that make it likely to be consistent with the target market described above, include:

Retail clients who are Australian residents and retail clients who are non-residents residing in Australia.
