Market Commentary

The quarter ending March 2020 saw the Fund pay 1.10% p.a., with the indicative rate for June 2020 set at 0.90% p.a. The Reserve Bank of Australia lowered rates twice during March, reducing the official cash rate to 0.25%, the lowest in Australian history. The outbreak of COVID-19 has caused Australia and many countries to shut their borders and place restrictions on businesses and individuals to slow the spread of the disease. This is causing significant disruption to economies around the world and has increased equity market volatility. Although the Fund doesn't suffer capital volatility the returns have fallen linked to the downward pressure on interest rates. The downward pressure on interest rates is expected to continue while the pandemic continues. Mortgage rates are at record lows and there is strong competition for high credit quality borrowers.
