Celebrating 10 years in the community



It gives me great pleasure to welcome you to our special 10th Birthday edition of our newsletter.

It has been my privilege to have been part of our **Community Bank®** branch from the very beginning. The process started with the feasibility study, followed by the pledging

stage, then the raising of funds through selling \$1 shares to our community and then culminating in the celebration of our launch date on 23 November 2005. It was an enormous boost to the Acacia Ridge community, being able to open our own bank after all other banks had left the Elizabeth St Shopping Centre.

The initial few years of our branch's history saw steady progress. One of our first initiatives was the YMCA Breakfast Club which started in 2008 and continues today to provide a nutritious start to the day for the children of busy working families.

Through the fine efforts of successful Branch Managers, Bettina Lumsden and her predecessor, Scott Northfield, and their staff, the **Community Bank®** branch business grew to a level where we were able to pay a return to the shareholders. In 2010, our first dividend of 4c per share was paid with a dividend paid every year since. Last year an 8c, fully franked dividend was paid.

I thank my fellow Board members, past and present, particularly Vicki Maguire, Linda Beaumont and Mark Ledwidge who have also been involved from the very beginning. Earle Johnston, our deputy-Chairman is in his 7th year with Amanda Harward and Jane Carlisle joining the Board in recent years. I acknowledge the time and the commitment of all our Directors and it is rewarding for the Board to be able to see the benefits provided to our community by our **Community Bank**® branch.

I also acknowledge the support and assistance of our franchise partner, Bendigo and Adelaide Bank Ltd. They have provided the experience, systems and support to both the branch and the Board.
