

From the Chairman.

Welcome to this Shareholders' Newsletter.

The Beaconsfield District **Community Bank**® Branch opened in September 2009 and continues to grow the business in the six and a half years of operation. The establishment of the branch, including the feasibility study and share capital raising was done at difficult economic times particularly impacted by the general financial crisis. Since opening interest rates on deposits and loans have declined resulting in reduced profit margins on banking business.

However, our **Community Bank**® branch has offset these negatives in income by growing the volume of business and we appreciate business generated from all customers including shareholders. A Community Bank® company shares in branch income generated from the banking operations with Bendigo and Adelaide Bank Ltd. The greater the level of Funds Under Management including deposits, loans, financial wealth, insurance products etc. the higher income generated for the Community Bank® company. The Beaconsfield District Community Bank® Branch commenced with total Funds Under Management of approximately \$9 million, which has now increased to \$73 million. The Board's Strategic Plan is to increase Funds Under Management by \$9 to \$10 million p.a. which assists greatly the "bottom line" of our Community Bank® company to become profitable.

Our **Community Bank®** company currently receives \$50,000 p.a. in Marketing Development Fund monies from Bendigo and Adelaide Bank Ltd. to financially support local not-for-profit organisations including Schools, Sporting

Clubs, CFA'S and Service Organisations. The Sponsorships involve developing a business relationship for the mutual benefit of the organisation and the **Community Bank**® branch. Articles in this newsletter demonstrate sponsorship support we are providing. Since the last Newsletter, Bruce Shaw retired as a Director and David Nutter was appointed as a Director of our **Community Bank**® company. Thank you to all Directors for their commitment and involvement in managing the **Community Bank**® company.
