Port Fairy & District **Community Bank**<sup>®</sup> Branch is pleased to announce that Bendigo Bank's new service, CommunityPOS<sup>™</sup>, is now available for local community group customers to borrow an EFTPOS terminal to take card payments when holding an event where payment of money is involved.

Providing they are Bendigo Bank customers, local community groups are able to apply for rental free temporary access to the EFTPOS terminal from the Port Fairy & District **Community Bank**<sup>®</sup> Branch. Once the event is over, the branch pays the funds directly into the group's nominated Bendigo Bank account.

Branch Manager, Ashley King said, "CommunityPOS™ is a convenient solution for community groups to accept card payments on the day of their event."

"We expect this to be a fantastic opportunity for schools, sports clubs and community organisations to use the service for registration days, membership drives or school fetes, fund raising and charitable events for example," Mr King said.

The introduction of this service is to eliminate the unnecessary year round cost of an EFTPOS terminal to community organisations that bank with Bendigo Bank, but still allows these organisations access to EFTPOS facilities on the occasions they require its use.

Although the service is available exclusively to Bendigo Bank customers, it is encouraged that community groups who don't bank with the Bendigo Bank at the Port Fairy & District **Community Bank**<sup>®</sup> Branch, think about dropping into the branch and see what we can offer for their group.
