Albert Lowerson VC Statue.

The Myrtleford RSL had been fund raising for two years to raise sufficient funds to commission a 110% life size bronze memorial of Albert David Lowerson. Born in Myrtleford in 1896, Mr Lowerson won the Victoria Cross in WW1 during the capture of Mont St Quentin.
