Sponsorship, donations and grants to Donald and district in the eight years of operation total over \$159,000 with the major sponsorship of \$20,000 going towards the Donald Stadium redevelopment – which is almost at the finish line.

Donald Skate Park.

Five young Donald residents, aged as young as 13 years old, started a petition 18 months ago to start the ball rolling for a skate park in Donald. The petition attracted over 100 signatures and was presented to the Buloke Shire. They were successful with State Government funding of \$140,000 for the project and now are working towards raising the final \$60,000 through the community.

Work on the Skate Park has begun, on the site of the former Scout Hall, and is drawing closer to finishing (as pictured on the first page of this newsletter).

Donald and District Community Bank Branch have contributed \$2,500 towards the Skate Park project and currently fundraising for this project sits at approximately \$30,000, leaving another \$30,000 to go.
