As the branch continues to grow, more and more funds become available for disbursement which will assist the community to pursue various projects, help other not-for-profits organisations to fulfil dreams and generally contribute to the prosperity of the district. The Company's prospectus states that it will take up to three years for the branch to become profitable however Bendigo provides funds to branches as soon as they reach minimum balance sheet footings of \$10 million. In this instance the amount distributed back is \$10,000 per annum. With each additional growth of \$5 million in footings, an additional \$5,000 is made available for distribution up to a ceiling of \$50,000 when footings reach \$50 million. Because of the fantastic support we have received prior to, and since, opening we have accumulated a footings of \$20 million giving us \$20,000 to give back over the next 12 months. The quicker we can grow this to \$50 million, the quicker we will be in a position to give back over \$4,000 per month back to the community.
