The CQ Driver Education Centre is an initiative of the CQ Motorsports Group. Located in Benaraby, Queensland, just 25 minutes south of the port city of Gladstone. It aims to provide an unparalleled driver training centre to the region. The Centre will target drivers who seek beginner to advanced 'real-life situation' courses, offroad courses and industry specific courses.

The CQ Driver Education Centre will take it to another level through giving drivers the opportunity to further improve their skills and be safer on the roads. Most importantly it will seek to meet the need of a broader community, providing the means and access to a purpose built and designated site. The Driver Education Centre would offer a formalised extension to the current significant contribution made by the CQ Motorsports Complex towards saving lives in the region with the operation of driver/rider training opportunities.

This facility will be the only such facility within a 500km radius and its facilities and its services will rival those in our larger capital cities. The Calliope & District **Community Bank**<sup>®</sup> Branch contribution will be \$250,000 toward this project, the training provided by these facilities has had significant impact on the reduction of injury and death in other parts of Australia where it is conducted, and we believe a facility like this is needed in our community. 
### **Calliope Rotary Medical Bus.**
