Calliope & District **Community Bank**[®] Branch – a short history.



A **Community Bank**[®] branch doesn't just happen, it has to be grown and nurtured like a garden, and it takes some interested people to not only start the seed growing, but also to push the idea along.

In Calliope those people were Kevin Marsh, who had the original idea, Jenny Miller who came along from Bendigo to give real substance to the idea, and Jenny Bubke who kept the dream alive through the next four years and became Chair for a further five years.

A steering committee was formed in 2005, including people from the Boyne Valley as well as Calliope. Its function was to sell enough \$1 shares to raise the \$600,000 required to start a **Community Bank**[®] branch and run it until it was profitable. Committee meetings were held in the RSL hall, in the back of the Railway Hotel and even in peoples' homes.

Over the next four years the committee members attended every Calliope River Historical Village market and events held as far as the Boyne Valley, Mt Larcom and Boyne Tannum. By 2009 the amount we needed to raise had extended to \$860,000 at the request of Bendigo Bank, but that was achieved with the help of the 13 Directors and 252 shareholders.

In March 2009 the Calliope & District **Community Bank**[®] Branch was declared open, with John Wessling as our Branch Manager (2009-18). Thanks to John working all hours, the bank became both profitable and highly decorated by the Bendigo Bank as one of Queensland's best **Community Bank**[®] branches.

We look forward to the next ten years of banking, with John Wessling now having progressed to Business Development Manager, and Joanna Lumley in her second year as Branch Manager with five full and part time staff.

It is thanks to past and present Directors, and to the shareholders and bank staff that we are celebrating a successful 10 years in the banking business today.
