The Doug Lindsay Reserve

Our **Community Bank**[®] branch provided a major contribution of \$50,000 to the Doug Lindsay Reserve Project with our particular interest being the establishment of the community multipurpose building. This facility will provide a home for many user groups, not only the sporting clubs, within the community as well as providing a function room capable of satisfying the needs of most business and personal events in Creswick.

As a result of our successful Ban the Bulb campaign (in which we employed volunteers from all the user groups) the sum of \$11,600 was raised and donated to the Doug Lindsay project. We also have an ongoing commitment to the Doug Lindsay Reserve with all of our profits from our Community Telco going to the management committee. Currently approximately \$130 per month is being raised through Community Telco and this can easily be increased significantly if the majority of our community came on board with their Telco services. John Curtin Aged Care Inc

Since opening, our **Community Bank**[®] branch has made significant contributions to the John Curtin Aged care facility. As we celebrate our 5th birthday it is a great opportunity to reflect what has happened over those five years and what we can expect into the future.

My objectives since our opening day, from a management point of view, was that in five years time we would have a successful branch, returning a satisfactory profit which would enable a satisfactory return to shareholders and at the same time make significant contributions back to local community projects.

Only in my wildest dreams would I have thought that we could achieve:

- Balance growth to \$110 million
- Opened 4,200 accounts
- \$170,000 in community contributions

Also, thanks to the generosity of our community, we have been able to provide \$129,000 in the form of Flood Relief grants to both individuals and not for profit organisations in both Creswick and Clunes. A big thank you to the Flood Relief Committee for a job well done during difficult circumstances.

Magic Pudding Playground
