


New jumping Castle for Hire.

In November 2014 the Board of Edenhope & District Financial Services Limited purchased a jumping castle that we can hire out to the Edenhope & District community.

The cost to hire the jumping castle is \$50 + gst for community organisations and \$150 + gst for individuals or businesses. This will cover the cost of insurance. The jumping castle will be delivered and set up at the start of your event and taken down and packed up at the end of the event by a Board member of Edenhope & District Financial Services Limited.

The plan is that the jumping castle can assist community organisations with fundraising for any event that they may have. The organisation can choose if they want to charge a fee to use the jumping castle which will help towards their fundraising efforts.
