

Supporting Junction Australia Marltarra Tiny Homes Campus

Junction Australia is a fantastic organisation that we're proud to support. Junction is in the business of positive change. They offer a range of **affordable**, **sustainable housing options for South Australians**, whether it's social housing tenancies or home ownership.

They define their impact as "positively impacting lives by creating opportunities for self-determined independence." Their assistance to communities also includes domestic violence services, homelessness support and financial wellbeing. They're particularly passionate about helping children and young people overcome trauma and adversity to reach their full potential.

One of their key priorities is to ensure that young people in residential care can transition to successful independent living when they turn 18. **The bank's \$120,000 donation over three years** will directly fund this goal, going towards the Marltarra Tiny Homes Campus, a collection of 10 new self-contained compact

homes. The transportable homes, custom-built off-site, are approximately 17sqm in size and feature modular, built-in furniture and storage, a work/study station and a kitchen. Each also have large windows for natural light and have been made available to 10 young people, aged between 16-18 who are leaving out-of-home care and don't have family support networks.

We're thrilled our '**Profit for Purpose'** model has allowed us to support such a fantastic initiative in the community.
