Reaching Out with Seddon Village



Every Monday evening since 2005, a small group of people set up in Nicholson Street Mall in Footscray to provide home cooked vegetarian meals, fruit and vegetables, snack packs, tea/coffee/milo/sugar, drinks, non-perishable food items, bread, adult clothing, shoes, toiletries, doonas, blankets, pillows, sleeping bags to people experiencing homelessness and those generally struggling.

Since 2020, Community Bank Seddon has embraced the local charity to support Randa, Ron, Paul and their team of volunteers in their mission to provide selfless service to the community.

The staff and customers have supported Reaching Out in the Inner West with collections of food, winter coats, blankets and volunteering at their Monday night service.

Over time, other businesses in Seddon Village have provided support by dry cleaning of donated coats, blankets, quilts and bedding and contributions of cooked meals, fresh produce and non-perishable items.

Randa says she has often been left speechless with the support Reaching Out in the Inner West has received. 'Thank you so much to the amazing Seddon Village! Scholarship Recipient - Zebib Gebralese



My name is Zebib and I received the first Community Bank Seddon scholarship when I completed Year 12 at Mt Alexander College in 2022. I am currently studying Global Studies at Latrobe University, majoring in International Relations at La Trobe University.

In the first semester I was on campus three to four days a week but due to the long distance from my home, I decided to attend once a week

and study the rest online. I like that I chose at least a day to be on campus because it's the time I get to socialise with my friends and classmates and see any programs the University has to offer.

The Community Bank Seddon scholarship has assisted with study expenses but also allowed me to consider participating in the Model United Nations (MOC UN) as an extension of my studies. A MOC UN is an educational simulation held in different locations around the world, where students can learn about diplomacy, international relations and the United Nations.

MOC UN's are held in different locations and schools depending on the topics. For instance, the topic 'Equality for Young Girls' was held in the Immigration Museum in Melbourne that I attended. One day it may be in Melbourne or New South Wales again depending on what the students are interested in.

I would like to thank the Board and staff of the Community Bank Seddon for the scholarship and appreciate the opportunities it has given me.

Vale Betty McClafferty

In 2006, at the age of 77, Betty was one of the original members of the steering committee who came together to spend two years fundraising to establish a Bendigo Bank Community Bank in Seddon. With a history in bookkeeping, her original role was to manage the weekly pledge balances.



When the bank was officially established in 2008, Betty became an inaugural Director. She remained on the Board until the first Shareholder dividend was paid in 2012 and retired at the age of 83. Betty continued to support the bank as a Shareholder and endeavoured never to miss an AGM.

While a passionate Seddon community member, Betty's passion also extended to a lifelong love of Judo. At the age of 93, she was a San Dan (3rd Degree Black Belt).

She was an active member and instructor of both Moonee Ponds and Newport Judo club for many years until she could no longer participate due to an extremely uncommon break in her right leg that refused to completely repair.

Betty was a valued and loved member of the Seddon community, Community Bank Seddon and the Newport Judo Club. She passed away on Tuesday 31 May at the age of 93 and will be dearly missed.
