the groups we support have got back into their regular activities.

Just this last week I dropped by the Little Teapot for a quick coffee and yummy cake and I was delighted to find that they were well on their way to doing what they do best; support young families and people new to our community. If you have never dropped by, you will find a lovely play space for young kids, as well as warm and welcoming volunteers providing lots of support for families. Over the years we have assisted them with improvements to their play spaces, so it was great to see it all being put to good use.

Our first grants round for 2021 was very well subscribed, with a wide range of great projects supported and over \$130,000 committed. As projects are completed, we will share the details via social media. In fact, the Geelong Independent picked up on our grant to the Wandarrah Arts and Craft Group who operate out of St Laurence Park aged care facility. It is a great story where we purchased two sewing machines to allow the volunteers to sew teddies and clothing for distribution to other

groups in need around Geelong, such as Geelong Mums and Cottage by the Sea.

At the end of March, I had the pleasure of attending the Lara CFA dedication of their new ultra-light tanker. While our bank contributed \$50,000, it was super pleasing that other local businesses and individuals provided around another \$130,000 to allow the volunteer brigade to have a highly valuable piece of equipment totally funded by the community.

We have now made our Share Registry more accessible to our shareholders by moving our registry to an online format. Shareholders can still use paper form if they wish, but they now also have the option of finding resources and information online for more efficiency.
