The TAC L2P Program is a community-based program developed to assist eligible young Victorian learner drivers between the ages of 16 and 21 years (and in some circumstances, up to 23 years) who do not have access to a supervising driver, or an appropriate vehicle to gain driving experience required for a probationary license.

The TAC L2P Program is funded by the TAC, administered by the Department of Transport and Planning and coordinated by City of Greater Geelong. It matches eligible learners with a vehicle and fully licensed volunteer mentor driver to help learners gain driving experience.
