

Company update.

Financially we had a strong year with a sizable profit. Our customer deposits and loans have increased from last year and our total funds under management has risen to \$159 million.

As always, a major factor in the ongoing growth and achievement of the company has been the continued high level of customer service provided by our team at the Leopold **Community Bank**[®] Branch, and for this we commend Craig Taylor and the team for their efforts.

In December 2018 we again paid a fully franked dividend to shareholders of 7 cents per share. This brings the total dividends paid to shareholders to 38 cents per share; with the total returns to shareholders being \$296,442. Our grants, sponsorship and donations to local community groups and projects has continued to grow. Since our commencement in 2009 we have provided a total of \$1.209 million in community advertising, grants, sponsorships and donations.
