COVID-19 - We're in this together

As an essential service our branch remains open for you but we take the health of our customers, employees, visitors and community seriously so have implemented safety measures that need to be adhered to when visiting our branch.

Our opening hours are from 9.30 am until 5.00 pm. We ask all our customers to take the right precautions before/when coming into our branch, including the use of the QR code register. We do have a manual register if you do not have a smart phone for the QR code. In the interests of public health, we are asking you to please, do not enter the branch if:

- You have recently returned from overseas or knowingly been in contact with someone who has been diagnosed with Coronavirus (COVID-19) or has returned from overseas in the past 14 days
- You are displaying flu-like symptoms.

Please take note of the signage in the branch and obey the two metre distance rule between others.

If you can't make it into the branch, you can get your banking done from your own home with the Bendigo Bank Internet Banking website or our App. Feel free to ask our friendly staff how to assist you.

This will allow you to:

- · Check account balances and transaction history
- · Make credit card and loan repayments
- · Make transfers, set up automatic payments and pay bills
- · Activate your card, create a PIN and set up your PayID
- · View your statements.
