Local Involvement Nationally Recognised

Bendigo and Adelaide Bank was announced as the 2015 winner of the National Red25 award for the highest number of blood donations with 1,754 donations and 5,262 lives saved! Thank you to all Elmore/Lockington/Rochester residents who have participated in the 'blood bus' program.

Bendigo and Adelaide Bank has been awarded the title of Australia's number one blood donor in the medium-sized organisation category, for the second year in a row.

Staff and Community volunteers made a whopping 1,754 donations to the Australian Red Cross Blood Service in 2015, eclipsing their nearest competition by more than 500 donations.

Accepting the 2015 award at a ceremony at Melbourne's RACV Club last week, Bendigo Bank Executive Robert Musgrove along with our own Kate Taylor, Chairman and Tracie Kyne, Senior Branch Manager of Elmore/Lockington/Rochester **Community Bank**[®] branches.

Mr. Musgrove said he was proud to represent hundreds of his colleagues and many locals from the Elmore/Lockington/Rochester communities who had rolled up their sleeves and saved lives.
