Giving juniors a sporting chance.

The next batch of sporting superstars in the Campaspe region will receive a boost after the launch of a new academy. The Campaspe Academy of Sport was recently launched after Rochester Secondary College signed a partnership agreement with Elmore/Lockington/Rochester Community Bank® branches. The academy is a sports education and athlete development program aimed at helping students in their pursuit of sporting and academic success. It emphasises the physical, mental and health benefits of physical activity and will include specialist coaches, guest speakers, sport science services and individualised training programs.
