Sixty individuals gathered together under sunshine and blue skies at the Elmore Cemetery on Sunday 4 June for the dedication of the new memorial wall. 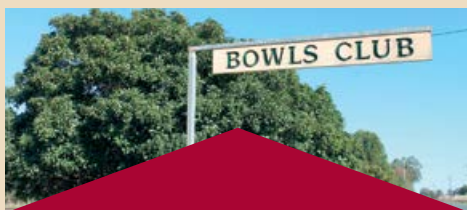

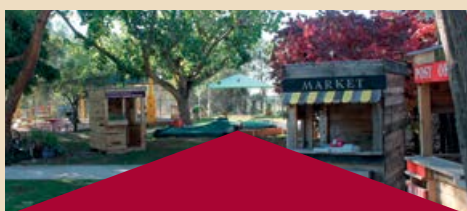
