Making an impact

The Doncaster East and Templestowe Village Community Bank Grants Program continues to be in high demand, with many new projects and initiatives funded in the Manningham community over recent months. Made possible through the many customers who choose to bank with the local Bendigo Bank branches, over \$4.5 million has been distributed to community initiatives since the Doncaster East branch opened 18 years ago.

Projects have included a grant of over \$30,000 to build a disabled toilet facility in the Kevin Heinze Grow precinct on Wetherby Road. The facility supports hundreds of participants each week through their horticultural therapy programs for individuals with disabilities. Their *Grow on the Go* program, has led to employment pathways for many of the participants – including Shannon and Victor – who are now both working part-time providing gardening services to

private clients. Victor says that the program taught him many skills including how to use the gardening equipment, how to be safe in the workplace and how to prepare quotes for customers. He says he learnt many things which he can now put into practice with his new job – his favourite tasks are mowing and whipper-snippering. The Community Bank donated the *Grow on the Go* van in 2018 and have enjoyed seeing it buzzing around Manningham with keen gardeners.

Connecting seniors through IT

Throughout the past 18 months many seniors in Manningham have struggled with the isolation and disconnection from their community. Many haven't had access to digital communication, so services such as Zoom, Skype and telehealth consultations were all out of reach.

In response, Doncare has developed a program to reduce isolation by increasing the knowledge and usability of IT by our seniors.

Funded by the Community Bank, the *Connecting Seniors Through IT* project will see a team of local volunteers trained to assist seniors develop their IT skills and confidence.

The program also provides access to loan digital devices. The group of volunteers will then train the next lot of volunteers through a 'train the trainer model' ensuring the service can continue for many years to come.
