Sponsorships to Mansfield and district community included:

Each primary school from the Mansfield Shire district received \$200 totalling \$1,200.00

Sport:

- Mansfield Junior Eagles Basketball Club received \$250 for training singlets and clothing to help keep the cost down for parents. The goal of this club is to give our children a chance to play basketball at a regional level as well as the local competition.

Budget

Barry Bird, Manager has set the budget for 2008/2009. An anticipated growth of 14M has been budgeted, in line with the prospective forecasts.

Community Bank® branch on target

Currently the Mansfield & District Community Bank® Branch has over \$29.5M in business.

We are well on track to achieve our prospectus forecasts for a number of benchmarks: break even, profit, accumulated profit and the payment of dividends.

The payment of share dividends was not anticipated before three years of trading, but the Board will be reviewing this timeframe at the end of the branch's first trading year.

Since the opening on 31 August 2007, we have passed a number of milestones.

- achieved over \$29M in funds balance
- our ATM is the 500th in an expanding network
