Causing a Stir.

Stir is a crowd-voted micro-grants platform for people in the ACT and nearby region. Its aim is to help creatives, both young and young-at-heart, to transform their passions into project proposals. In doing so, it provides tools that help develop their entrepreneurial spirit, and the exposure necessary to build a positive disposition towards commercialising their work. Finally, it invites people from the community to vote on projects to determine who will receive a \$1,000 Stir Grant to help them get started.

It is an initiative of the Canberra (CBR) Innovation Network and was collaboratively designed by a community of local creatives in line with their needs for support and empowerment. Stir was launched in March 2015, and since then has received over 70 creative projects, which have been viewed over 100,000 times on their website.

Season Two ran between 10 May – 29 June this year, and with our help, was able to provide 10 micro-grants of \$1,000 to a diverse set of individuals and teams looking to pursue meaningful careers. The grant receiving projects, and their descriptions as provided by their authors, were:

TeachPad - A beautiful platform for students to find tutors for anything

VacantSpace – Revitalising Canberra city by making vacant commercial spaces available for short-term community and creative use

Asili - A small café serving coffee, African street food with a generous serve of "Ubuntu"

Trejavu – A platform connecting travellers with local guides for a more authentic travel experience.
