The Limestone Coast Prostate Cancer Support Group (pictured above) have been tirelessly fundraising for some time to raise money for the purchase of a transperineal biopsy machine for local hospitals. Having the biopsy machine in the South East will save patients having to travel long distances for the procedure.

We are very proud to be able to provide \$10,000 towards the machine purchase (through our Community Investment Grants Program). It is hoped that the machine, costing over \$180,000, will be purchased this year. This is a great example of how we can provide funding to our communities from the support of our customers.

Giving back to the community
