In 2020 (just as the pandemic hit) things started to turn around, more and more people started to bank with our branch. In 2021 we relocated to under the clock tower where we are today.

The board of directors has also seen many changes, at times it has been very difficult to attract directors. Last year saw Community Bank Mount Martha's first Chairman, Nicholas Roberts OAM, step down after 13 years, Nick still remains on the board as a director. Our board is now the strongest ever with a diverse group of ladies and gentlemen that give up their time to help guide our/your branch.

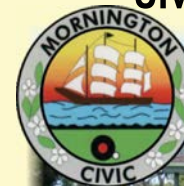
