Bond Store Re-Opening

The little building tucked away along the footpath between Bowden Street and the Skate Park, has received some renovations.

The Penola branch of the National Trust have come to an arrangement with the Coonawarra Vignerons Association for the use of the building as wine storage - which coincidentally, this building was originally the storage place of the town's liquor supply prior to federation in 1901!

Through a Bendigo Bank Community Grant, the funds were provided to undertake the restoration and preservation of this building.
