Back in March 2023 Community Bank Pinewood were very excited to fund a new car for the TAC L2P program for the City of Monash area. Later that month we welcomed learner driver Kiana and her mentor John along with staff from the Southeast Community Links (SECL) to the branch. Community Bank Pinewood are proud supporters of the L2P program and love the look of the new car which will now be used to help learner drivers like Kiana obtain their required minimum of 120 hours of supervised driving experience. Only two weeks after the car was being used in the community, we had our first probationary licence success! The learner in question got his last 20 hours of practice in the Suzuki which was crucial for him to obtain enough hours to be eligible to sit his test.

Southeast Community Links are currently looking for volunteer driving mentors who are over 21 years old, hold a full Australian driver's license and can commit to around two to three hours per week of learner driver support. John told us he has been a mentor for almost eight years now and finds it such a fulfilling role – we commend him on all the work he has done! 
