17. The Promoter reserves the right, at any time, to validate and check the authenticity of entrants (including an entrant's identity, age and place of residence). In the event that a winner cannot provide suitable proof as required by the Promoter to validate their entry, the winner will forfeit the prize in whole and no substitute will be offered.
