When asked how this will benefit the community, Lyn from the Hillman Community Association commented "...the fitness equipment will be along a major pathway giving everyone in the community access at no cost. This will contribute to the fitness and wellbeing of everyone within the Hillman community. We are looking to have a personal trainer come and demonstrate how to use the equipment."

Lyn went on further to say that "...the equipment will also allow parents to workout whilst waiting for their children at the local school."

Rockingham Community Shed for Men shared in the prize money by picking up \$1,500 in second place. This will be utilised in helping expand the floor space of the shed to incorporate new members.

Rockingham Volunteer Sea Rescue Group received \$500 in third place which will



aid in the purchasing of brand new safety equipment for their boat.

Final figures were Hillman Community Association winning with 709 votes; second place was Rockingham Community Shed for Men on 589 votes and Rockingham Volunteer Sea Rescue Group with 179 votes in third position.

The Hillman Community Association thanked Rockingham and Port Kennedy **Community Bank®** branches for their support and all those who voted throughout the campaign.
