Appeal for more shareholders to bank with us

You may not be aware, but to protect the confidentiality of shareholders and bank customers, the Board has no idea who the customers of Rockingham Community Financial Services (RCFS) are, unless they disclose that information themselves.

Bendigo has advised us that only 25% of **Community Bank®** shareholders actually bank with the branch they are shareholders of. I must admit I find this an alarming statistic. I do not mind disclosing the fact that as soon as possible I moved all of my personal lending and business lending and banking across to Bendigo, and I am not even a shareholder, but I do support the **Community Bank®** model of the bank and am very happy to represent Bendigo where I can to colleagues and business associates.

I am curious to understand why so many shareholders trust us with their cash to invest and maximise returns, but do not trust us with their banking needs, which in turn helps achieve the primary goals of supporting the local community and shareholder value and returns.

I would like to demonstrate this point as follows:

For every \$500,000 of banking products (by way of mortgage, term deposit, business loan, credit card, personal loan, super fund investments) the local branch receives income of around \$4,000 per annum.

RCFS has 477 shareholders, and if only 25% of these are Bendigo customers, there are nearly 360 shareholders who use other banks for their needs.

If 30 shareholders brought an average of \$500,000 in banking products to RCFS the branch would earn additional revenue of around \$120,000 per annum that would be used to support Rockingham and Port Kennedy by way of additional employment, services and community support and additional returns to shareholders.

I say this with the utmost respect of our shareholders and with appreciation for their support so far. I only use this example to demonstrate to power we all have to help support our local branch even further with our choices. I urge all shareholders to please consider using Bendigo for their banking needs if at all possible.
