As RCFS shares are listed on the National Stock Exchange (NSX) you will need a broker who deals with this exchange. The NSX website is listed below and on it you can find details of various brokers who deal in NSX shares. Brokers will charge a fee for their service, and this varies between brokers, however they will be able to handle most of the transaction for you from the initial sale to the settlement. In some cases they may request information such as share certificates from you. If you have your certificate they may want to verify that it's genuine so be prepared to send them the relevant information. If you can't find your certificate you will need to contact the share registry on (08) 9527 2133.
