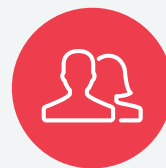

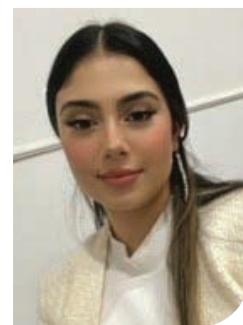
Introducing Sahra
