\$10,000 St Anne's Catholic Primary School Sarina

St Anne's Catholic Primary School students have branched out into the 21st century thanks to funds from Sarina **Community Bank**[®] Branch.

Special bed donated to the Sarina Hospital

A \$12,500 specialised bed has made life more comfortable for palliative, rehabilitation and chronically ill patients in Sarina Hospital, thanks to the donation from Sarina **Community Bank**[®] Branch.

The specialised bed and air mattress called Versa Bed, cares for very sick and terminally ill patients in the Sarina and district community. It will benefit patients who will be able to stay or transfer to Sarina Hospital for their treatment and nursing care, instead of having to travel to Mackay for their treatment.





"We have one Versa Bed at the Sarina Hospital and without the support of Sarina **Community Bank**[®] Branch we would have found it difficult to purchase a second one. This special bed is in constant use, aids the very ill patients to minimise pressure injuries and aids our nursing staff to provide continuous high quality care for our patients." Maura Keogh, Director of Nursing at Sarina Hospital said.
