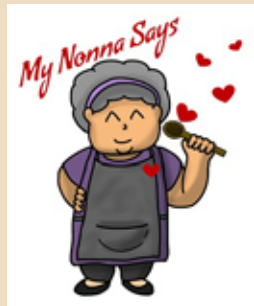
We have a new agency in Texas.
