The total amount of money distributed by the Mirboo North & District **Community Bank**[®] Branch to the Mirboo North, Boolarra and Yinnar Districts has now exceeded \$227,000 during the past four years.

By December this year our grants program will have distributed approximately \$107,000 to the community over three years.
