Trafalgar & District **Community Bank**[®] Branch opened its doors for business in November 2003, almost 10 years ago, after a lot of hard work by some dedicated volunteers within the community.

Following the closure of a number of bank branches operated by the major banks, community members approached Bendigo Bank to explore the option of establishing a **Community Bank**[®] Branch in Trafalgar.

The result saw the community establish a public company that operates a franchise of Bendigo Bank. A steering committee worked tirelessly to promote the creation of a **Community Bank**[®] branch, to stimulate interest and, finally, to raise the necessary capital for the project to proceed.

Today we employ six staff members, have loans and deposits exceeding \$100 million and contribute substantially to the community.

To date, Trafalgar & District **Community Bank**[®] Branch has distributed more than \$750,000 to local community organisations through its sponsorship and grants programs and is looking forward to the day when it passes the \$1 million mark. We expect to have reached this target by the end of 2013.
