Community Relationship Manager, Matt, attended the Lockleys Football Club Sponsors Day in August and although the game result wasn't ideal, it was a great opportunity for him to connect with key club members and fellow sponsors and see the video screen scoreboard in action that we helped fund. It's always great to see the real difference our sponsorship makes to our local clubs and their members.

Matt also visited the Rotary Bookmart and was amazed by the volunteer effort behind its success, generating \$42K in 2024/25 from just 20 hours of trading a week. He also viewed the publicly accessible defibrillator outside the Bookmart; co-funded through a Community Bank West Beach grant.

Projects like the Shelterbags and Bookmart defibrillator, show how our profits go directly back into supporting the people and causes that matter most.

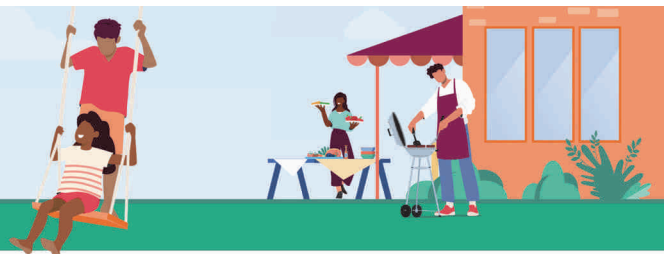
